EUR/USD
EUR/USD extends its gains to 1.0520 as the US Dollar weakens due to lower US Treasury yields ahead of the Federal Reserve's expected 25 basis point rate cut on Wednesday. The Euro is supported by political stability in France and a cautious tone from the European Central Bank regarding rate cuts, with ECB officials emphasizing the importance of price stability over economic stimulus.

GBP/USD
The GBP/USD pair rises slightly after snapping a three-day losing streak, trading around 1.2630, ahead of crucial central bank meetings this week, including the Federal Reserve's expected rate cut on Wednesday and the Bank of England's decision on Thursday. The Fed's policy statement, economic projections, and Jerome Powell's comments will be key for USD dynamics, while the BoE is expected to hold rates steady, with concerns about future inflation limiting bullish sentiment for the British Pound.

USD/JPY
The Japanese Yen falls to a three-week low against the US Dollar, weighed down by expectations that the Bank of Japan will not raise interest rates and rising US Treasury yields. While stronger-than-expected Japanese economic data provided no relief, traders are cautious ahead of the Bank of Japan's decision and the Federal Reserve's policy meeting this week, with geopolitical risks offering limited support to the Yen.

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell for a seventh session on Friday, posting its longest run of losses since 2020. The Federal Reserve's decision on Dec. 18 stateside will be top of mind for investors, with the CME Fedwatch tool forecasting a 96% chance of a 25-basis-points cut.

EUROPE
European markets closed lower Friday as investors reacted to disappointing data prints from two of the region's largest economies. Friday's downbeat mood followed unexpected declines in both U.K. GDP and key export data from Germany. In France, President Emmanuel Macron named Francois Bayrou his new prime minister on Friday.

ASIA
Asia-Pacific markets were mostly down on Monday, reversing earlier gains with investors looking to several major central bank decisions due this week including the Bank of Japan and the People's Bank of China. The BOJ is likely to hold rates when it releases its decision on Thursday, while the PBOC will announce its loan prime rates on Friday.

Moody's downgrades France credit rating to Aa3
Ratings agency Moody's downgraded France's credit rating Saturday, December 13, to Aa3 with a stable outlook, following months of political crisis and the appointment of centrist Francois Bayrou as prime minister. Moody's cited France's "political fragmentation" in its decision, which comes after parliament ousted Michel Barnier's government in a historic no-confidence vote following a standoff over an austerity budget. "The decision to downgrade France's ratings to Aa3 reflects our view that France's public finances will be substantially weakened by the country's political fragmentation which, for the foreseeable future, will constrain the scope and magnitude of measures that could narrow large deficits," the ratings agency said in a statement. Bayrou's appointment makes him France's fourth prime minister this year, with Barnier being booted out after just three months in office. The newly appointed premier faces the immediate challenge of forming a cabinet that can survive a no-confidence vote in a divided parliament and thrashing out a 2025 budget in a bid to limit economic turmoil. "In a highly politically fragmented environment, there is now very low probability that the next government will sustainably reduce the size of fiscal deficits beyond next year," Moody's said. The ratings agency opened the door to downgrading France in October, when it changed the country's outlook from stable to negative.
